5 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

- 5.1 Signals made ashore will be displayed at the **main flagpole**. **Describe location**
- 5.2 When flag AP is displayed ashore, ‘1 minute’ is replaced with ‘**not less than 45 minutes**’ in Race Signals AP. This changes race signals AP.
- 5.3 **[DP] Flag D with one sound means boats shall not leave the shore until this signal is made. The warning signal will not be made before the scheduled time or less than XX minutes after flag D is displayed.**

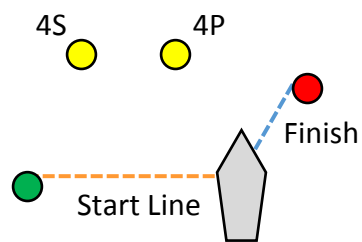
