5. Technical

Jim Hood, Technical manager from RS Sailing joined the meeting for this item.

A discussion arose about shroud failure, and the purpose of the ferrule. It was agreed that Andy Jones would trial sailing without a ferrule and report back.

A question was raised about whether masts and spinnakers could be ordered from RS Sailing, as these items are showing out of stock. SC agreed to take up with Andy Taphouse at RS.

A question was raised about the possibility of new boats. Previous communication from RS was that an order of around 10 would be needed to make this viable. It was thought that there was interest in about 5 boats from Australia. David agreed to discuss with the Australian RS100 Chairman and RS Sailing and report to the committee. If new boats are possible David to also consider potential changes, e.g. strengthening deck in shroud plate area.

It has been a difficult year, with only 3 events to date, that had all had good attendance, especially the Nationals with Netley sailors especially welcome.
